DRESS REHEARSALS: (1ST) Saturday, May 13, 2017 AT THE STUDIO (designated times forthcoming)
(2ND) Thursday, June 1, AT 4:30 P.M. AT THE HIGH SCHOOL AUDITORIUM
There will be a general meeting prior to a finale rehearsal.
Please inform Wanda ASAP if you have an important conflict and would like your number scheduled at a certain time for the dress rehearsals or recital. We will do our best to accommodate you.

FIRST DRESS REHEARSAL (SATURDAY, MAY 13) FULL DRESS: This rehearsal will not run in the order of the “real” show, so students in a single number will probably not be at the school for more than an hour. Check the rehearsal schedule for reporting time. Plan to arrive **15 minutes before your scheduled time** to avoid any delays in the following numbers that your tardiness may cause. Wear costumes, make-up and appropriate hairstyle. **No males will be permitted in the female dressing rooms.** Group pictures will be taken immediately before rehearsing at the Studio.

SECOND DRESS REHEARSAL (THURSDAY, JUNE 1) FULL DRESS: will begin PROMPTLY at 4:30 P.M. for all participants. We will run through the “Finale” first, then proceed through each number in show order. Students will be permitted to leave after all of their numbers have been rehearsed.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: Rehearsal times and show order will be posted at the studio and on our website.

PLEASE plan to stop in at the studio or check our website or facebook page to see the schedule.

TICKET INFORMATION: Reserved seats are \$13.00 each, no limit. Infants on laps do not need tickets. Tickets go on sale Saturday, May 20, between 9:30 A.M.-2:30 P.M.

In fairness to all families, please do not ask us to “hold” unpaid tickets, or phone in your ticket orders. Tickets will also be sold at the studio during regular office hours starting Monday, May 22. Tickets will be sold at the high school on the day of the recital as long as they are available.

MUSICAL THEATRE SHOWCASE

PRIVATE VOICE AND MUSICAL THEATRE STUDENTS WILL HAVE A SEPARATE PERFORMANCE. MORE INFORMATION WILL BE FORTHCOMING.

COSTUME DISTRIBUTION: All costumes will be distributed during class times. If a student is absent, a parent must make arrangements to pick up the costume(s).

TIGHTS: Danskin Theatrical Pink for designated ballet numbers and Classic Light Toast for designated tap and jazz. New convertible tights can be purchased from us for \$12.00 for adult sizes and \$11.00 for children's sizes per pair. Payment is expected when picking them up.

FOOTWEAR: Pink ballet slippers for most ballet numbers. Black tap shoes for most numbers, but check with the tap teacher to be sure. Black jazz shoes for jazz numbers, but once again, check with the jazz teacher to confirm the correct color.

HAIR STYLES: Ballet numbers – bun on back of head unless otherwise instructed by teacher.
Tap and Jazz – hair styled and off the face.

MAKEUP: Since this is a legitimate stage performance with intense lighting, makeup on everyone is a MUST. Girls ages 12 and under: eye shadow, blush and red lipstick. Girls ages 13 and older: base, blush, eye shadow, mascara and red lipstick. **No colored fingernail polish.** Makeup is necessary for both rehearsals. **No jewelry** unless specified by teacher.

DRESSING ROOMS: Keep them orderly. Do not throw costumes and street clothes on the floor.

CONDUCT: We must **insist on quiet in the auditorium** to get the show done effectively. **NO STUDENTS IN COSTUME ARE PERMITTED IN THE AUDITORIUM DURING THE RECITAL. NO FOOD OR DRINK ALLOWED IN THE AUDITORIUM. SMOKING IS NOT PERMITTED.** Do not permit children to run/play in the aisles during the performance.

DVD RECORDING: A professional videographer will record the recital. **No other video cameras will be permitted in the auditorium.** Video taping is permitted at the Thursday, June 1 dress rehearsal.

(*) PHOTOGRAPHER: A professional photographer will be taking all group and individual pictures during the Dress Rehearsals on May 13.

FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY: Please take pictures in the hall, dressing room, outdoors, etc., but not in the auditorium during the performance.

**All tuition and any outstanding balances on your child's account must be paid in full and up to date in order for your child to participate in the recital. If you are not sure of your account status, please speak with Wanda during normal office hours (4:00 – 8:00 P.M., Monday – Thursday and Saturday, 9:30 A.M. – 1:30 P.M.).
